## Buddy Programme

A Buddy Programme is organized at IBS-Moscow. Each exchange student will be assigned a “buddy”, who will help him integrate in IBS-Moscow’s academic and cultural world. So, a buddy is a kind of a coach who will help you in your daily life at IBS-Moscow and in Moscow (finding accommodation, understanding your course schedules, helping you to register for exams, understand formalities regarding accommodation etc.)

# Campus Facilities and Infrastructure

## ACCOMMODATION

IBS-Moscow has on-site student residence at 82, Prospect Vernadskogo, Building #4, Moscow, 119571, Russian Federation.

The closest metro station is Yugo-Zapadnaya (Red line).

Students are accommodated in shared rooms.

Each room is equipped with the following items:

- Desk
- TV set
- 2 single beds
- Mattresses, blankets and pillows
- Bed linen and towels
- Bathroom

Residents are asked to purchase their own cutlery and kitchen utensils, laundry detergents, and shampoo and shower gels. Rooms are provided only for registered students, and no one else is permitted to stay overnight.


